AUSTRALIA DAY CRUISING EXTRAVAGANZA SET FOR CALDER PARK

CAR enthusiasts are racing to enter a cruising event with a difference that is set to rock Calder Park this Australia Day weekend.

Capped at a maximum of only 300 entrants, Vic Supercruz sets itself apart from other street machine events by seeking to attract the best of Australia's cars and drivers for the January 26-27 event.

Organiser Dean Arundell said close to 20 blown cars had already entered and six of the country's top 10 blown pro street cars had been confirmed for drag displays during the Vic Supercruz.

"We were going to charge less and open up the entry to anyone but felt our event would be the same as every one else. We decided instead to charge a little more and cap the entry to a maximum of 300 to ensure all entrants get plenty of track time and don't have to wait," Mr Arundell said.

"We wanted to attract some nice cars but the quality of cars that have entered so far have even blown us away. We just hope that it has not discouraged the entrants that we are looking for."

It's not just the drivers' glory at stake in the Vic Supercruz events, with thousands of dollars in cash prizes to ensure fierce competition.

Prizes, including a blown 350 Chevrolet show motor and a ride in a blown pro street car, will also be given away to prepaid entrants and spectators.

Combined give-away and competition prizes exceed \$35,000, which includes more than \$13,000 in cash prizes for the drag racing and burnouts competitions.

Other events include the Supercruz, the doughnut sprint challenge, the straight line super burnouts, Show'n'Shine, drifting Vic Supercruz-style, Go-to-whoa shootout and dyno competition.

"We hope to offer what we feel is one of the highest quality street machine events seen in Victoria," Mr Arundell said.

"We can't wait for the weekend and hope to put on a show that everyone talks about for a long time. Bring it on!"

Organisers hope to make the events regular, indicating they could be run as often as two or three times a year.
